

This Privacy and Cookie Policy describes our policy on the use of privacy and cookies at Vexcolt (UK) Ltd.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small amount of data, often including a unique identifier that is sent to your computer or mobile device (referred to here as a “device”) from your browser from the web server and stored on your device’s hard drive. Each website or third-party service provider that uses the website may send its own cookies to your browser if your browser preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a website or third-party service provider to access cookies it has sent to you, not cookies sent by other sites or other providers. A cookie will contain certain anonymous information, such as a unique identifier and the name of the site and some digits and numbers. It allows a website to remember things like your preferences or to identify the device for analytical and tracking purposes.

How do we use cookies?

We use only cookies that are strictly necessary to enable you to move around the website, to provide certain basic features and to improve the performance of our website and provide you with a better user experience. Generally, we use cookies to provide the following services through the pages of our websites:

Session cookies : Necessary for our website to function properly, for example, to know if you are logged in or to remember your language preferences.

Cookie tracking: To provide anonymous statistical information so that we can tell how many visits we have, how many users we have, what browsers they are using (so that we can maximize compatibility for the majority of our users) and, in some cases, what country, city or region they are in.

How can I control cookies?

You can accept or decline the use of cookies on our sites by clicking on the “accept” or “decline” button that will appear at the top of the page when you first visit our website. You can also change your browser settings to refuse all cookies, allow only trusted websites, or to delete stored cookies that you have on your device.
